



Emergency Assistance

Last month, Los Ojos de la Familia received two urgent cries for help, and we were happily able to help the two families.

Richard Jinzo and Eleanor Molina recently delivered their 2nd child, Ayden Jinzo, 7-weeks premature, and after a few days, he was diagnosed with pneumonia and Respiratory Distress Syndrome. Several forms of treatment have been attempted, and the family is hopeful that a specialist in Denver will be able to help the baby breathe on his own. However, Eleanor has already exceeded her maternity leave, and the family is struggling to make ends meet, with increase medical expenses, while she cares for the child. We gave the family a \$400 gift card to Walmart, to help with everyday needs.



Update as of 3/1/12: The Jinzo family was very grateful for the gift card. It looks like the family will be leaving for Denver for a lung biopsy and possibly putting in a permanent trachea for Ayden.

Angelica de Agüero is a woman with cancer, who recently underwent surgery, and will be going through radiation and chemotherapy for another 6-8 weeks. She is a restaurant server, on an unpaid leave of absence. Her family and friends have been helping as much as they can, with various fundraisers, but with no income, she needs all the help she can get. We gave her a \$400 Walmart gift card to help with living expenses.
