# October 2017 Emergency Assistance



*Last month our board voted unanimously to help several deserving families and individuals, who needed urgent assistance.*

**Jedediah Encinias** was recently involved in a rollover accident, which forced to him to enroll in short term disability while he recovers. His son is currently in an out-of-state facility due to disability, for which he and his wife must visit monthly for treatment and meetings. He hasn't been able to see his son since the accident several months ago, and they have fallen behind on a few bills. We wrote a check to their landlord, to help toward them getting caught up on rent.

**Juanita Trujillo** is a survivor of cancer, who suffers from Multiple Sclerosis, and is currently living on a fixed income. She is unable to work, and her monthly income barely meets her financial obligations. She recently lost her water heater and heater, and she had to use the money she saved for property taxes to replace the appliances. We helped her pay a portion of her property taxes.

**Dion Casias** is a single father of a teenager, but a recent illness/injury put him out of work for several weeks. He has been working again, but with limited hours while he goes through the recovery process. We wrote a check to the landlord to help with a portion of their rent.

**Jennifer Avalos** is a single mother of three, who works to support her family, but whose hours have been cut back recently. With her reduced income, she has fallen behind on a few of her bills. We wrote a check to help her with part of their rent.

**Maria Perez** is the head of her family, with four children. They have been having a hard time financially lately, and she asked for help with utility bills, so they can keep the heater on for the upcoming winter. We helped them get caught up with their PNM and NM Gas bills.
